A BILL

To amend the Help America Vote Act of 2002 to require States to implement procedures for tracking ballots which are transmitted by mail, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Mail-In Ballot Track-
- 5 ing Act of 2007".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR TRACKING BALLOTS TRANS-
2	MITTED BY MAIL.
3	(a) Requiring States To Meet Require-
4	MENTS.—Subtitle A of title III of the Help America Vote
5	Act of 2002 (42 U.S.C. 15481 et seq.) is amended—
6	(1) by redesignating sections 304 and 305 as
7	sections 305 and 306; and
8	(2) by inserting after section 303 the following
9	new section:
10	"SEC. 304. REQUIREMENTS FOR TRACKING BALLOTS
11	TRANSMITTED BY MAIL.
12	"(a) In General.—
13	"(1) Tracking requirements.—Each State
14	and jurisdiction which transmits ballots by mail in
15	the administration of an election for Federal office
16	shall implement such procedures as the State or ju-
17	risdiction considers appropriate to ensure that the
18	ballots may be tracked throughout the administra-
19	tion of the election, including procedures to ensure
20	that—
21	"(A) the appropriate election official may
22	track the progress of the ballot through the
23	mail from the time it is transmitted to the voter
24	until it is received by the appropriate election
25	official; and

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1	"(B) a voter who casts a ballot by mail
2	may track the progress of the ballot using the
3	Internet, an automated telephone system, and
4	such other methods as the State or jurisdiction
5	considers appropriate.
6	"(2) Specific events to be tracked.—
7	Under the procedures implemented pursuant to this
8	subsection, an individual shall be able to determine
9	whether each of the following has occurred with re-
10	spect to a ballot transmitted by mail:
11	"(A) The ballot has been transmitted by
12	the appropriate election official.
13	"(B) The ballot has been processed by the
14	Postal Service, including the determination of
15	the date and time of processing and the location
16	of the processing facility involved.
17	"(C) After the individual has submitted
18	the ballot by mail, the ballot has been received
19	by the appropriate election official.
20	"(D) The appropriate election official has
21	made a determination as to whether or not the
22	ballot has been validly cast, including whether
23	or not the individual has met any applicable

signature requirements.

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1	"(E) The ballot has been counted or re-
2	jected by the appropriate election official.
3	"(3) Protection of Privacy of Informa-
4	TION.—In carrying out paragraph (1), the State and
5	jurisdiction shall ensure that a ballot may be tracked
6	without revealing or exposing the content of the bal-
7	lot to unauthorized individuals.
8	"(b) Exception for Ballots of Absent Over-
9	SEAS AND MILITARY VOTERS.—The requirements of this
10	section do not apply with respect to a ballot which is trans-
11	mitted to or submitted by an individual who is entitled
12	to vote by absentee ballot under the Uniformed and Over-
13	seas Citizens Absentee Voting Act.
14	"(c) Effective Date.—This section shall apply
15	with respect to the regularly scheduled general election for
16	Federal office held in November 2010 and each succeeding
17	election for Federal office.".
18	(b) Availability of Enforcement.—Section 401
19	of such Act (42 U.S.C. 15511) is amended by striking
20	"and 303" and inserting "303, and 304".
21	(c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
22	of such Act is amended—
23	(1) by redesignating the items relating to sec-
24	tions 304 and 305 as relating to sections 305 and
25	306: and

1	(2) by inserting after the item relating to sec-
2	tion 303 the following new item:
	"Sec. 304. Requirements for tracking ballots transmitted by mail.".
3	SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF REQUIREMENTS PAYMENTS
4	FOR STATES.
5	Section 257(a) of the Help America Vote Act of 2002
6	(42 U.S.C. 15407(a)) is amended by adding at the end
7	the following new paragraph:
8	"(4) For fiscal year 2008, such sums as may be
9	necessary.".

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
